

Instruction Sheet for Citizenship Children of Grenadian Parent over 18 Years of Age

- **1.** One completed form **signed** by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public.
- 2. Four Passport size photographs **CERTIFIED** by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public.
- **3. ORIGINAL** and **ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY** of Birth Certificate.
- **4.** Police Certificate of Character.
- **5.** Reference letter from a reputable person in the community.
- 6. Medical Certificate from a Registered Practitioner.
 - a) Chest X-Ray
 - **b)** Malaria Blood Smear
 - **c)** Serum Creatinine
 - d) RPR, VDRL or other serologic test for Syphilis
 - e) Stool for culture and Microscopic examination
 - **f)** HIV antibody test
 - g) Updated immunization status including measles, mumps, rubella, tetanus and hepatitis B
 - * Immunization card <u>MUST</u> be produced.
 - Copy of Immunization card.

Persons traveling from high – risk areas or who have had recent malarial infection should be suitably treated with Promaguine.

(This test <u>must</u> be conducted within <u>six (6) months</u> of the date of application and must be done at the General Hospital Laboratory)

NB: Contact Number should be included on application.

- 7. ORIGINAL and ONE (1) PHOTOCOPY of Birth Certificate of Grenadian Parent.
- **8.** Fee **EC\$250.00** plus **EC\$5.10** transaction fee to be made payable to "**Government of Grenada**" (*International Postal Order/Cashier's Cheque only*). Persons residing in Great Britain and Canada should make money order or Cashier's Cheque equivalent to **EC\$255.10**. Persons residing in the United States of America make money order or Cashier's Cheque for **US\$94.90**.
