ST GEORGE'S, July 5, 2013 – Women's football in Grenada may soon have a title sponsor, this after the Grenada Football Association (GFA) and Beacon Insurance Company Limited recently held talks about the sport on the island.

It has been reported that Country Manager, Molly Roberts expressed an interest in supporting women's football as well as forging a new relationship with the GFA, during a meeting with the association's boss Cheney Joseph.
