

St Patrick Clubs Want GFA to Act on Fond Football Project



ST GEORGE'S, July 5, 2013 – Football clubs in St Patrick are urging the Grenada Football Association (GFA) to act quickly to secure the Fond Special Project under the FIFA Development Programme.

This was among issues discussed with the President of the GFA, Cheney Joseph at a meeting in Fond on Wednesday.

It has been more than six months since FIFA approved the project but is yet to receive formal documents from the GFA. FIFA has since set a deadline of July 8 to receive the requisite documents including the project description and preliminary design.

The GFA President also updated the clubs on the FIFA Goal Project, Grassroots, Youth and Women football, Sponsorship and the status of the 2013 League Tournament.

The clubs requested a review of the format of the Premier League including the playing of games only in enclosed fields. They want some these matches to be contested on community fields which will encourage more community participation.

The clubs also expressed concerns about the non-functioning of some executive members of the GFA and warned that if they are not willing to work in the best interest of affiliates then they will request through Council for these members to set aside.

Joseph promised to discuss their concerns and suggestions with his executive.
