## REQUIREMENTS FOR PROCESSING VISA APPLICATIONS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL IN GRENADA

- **1.** Application **MUST** be completed in **BLUE** or **BLACK** ink.
- **2.** Applications **MUST** be made at least **6 weeks PRIOR** to departure date.
- 3. The processing time for the application is approximately **ten (10) business days** from date of receipt.
- **4.** Applicant's passport <u>MUST</u> be valid for at least **6 months from date of departure from Grenada** and accompany application.
- **5.** Only a **FULLY COMPLETED** Visa Application Form will be accepted.
- **6. TWO (2)** Passport pictures (*no more than 3 months old*), one certified by a **Justice of the Peace** or a **Notary Public**.
- **7.** Application for a **Single–Entry** Visa is **US\$100.00** per applicant. Application for a **Multiple–Entry** Visa is **US\$250.00** per applicant.
  - i. ONLY CERTIFIED CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS ARE ACCEPTED.
  - ii. CASH accepted IN PERSON ONLY.
  - iii. If the Visa is to be mailed back to you, please include a **separate money order** either for **US\$20.00** for Express Service (*mailing within the USA*), or **US\$60.00** for Express International Service (*mailing outside the USA*). Money order(s) are payable to **Embassy of Grenada**.
- **8.** U.S. Permanent Residents who require a Visa to visit Grenada must also show proof of permission to re–enter the U.S. (*Please bring your Residency Card with you to Embassy or if mailing, photocopy both sides of your card on one page and have it notarized*).
- **9.** Visas are valid for only the period of time specified.
- 10. Holders of Visas may not work in Grenada unless authorized to do so by the local Ministry of Labour.
- 11. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED FOR ISSUANCE OF VISA:
  - i. Passport
  - ii. Completed Visa Application
  - iii. Passport valid for at least 6 months from date of departure from Grenada
  - iv. Two (2) passport pictures (*no more than 3 months old*), one certified by a **Justice of the Peace** or a **Notary Public**
  - v. If you are a Permanent Resident of the US (*Please bring your Residency Card with you or notarized copy see No. 8 above*)
  - vi. One money order for visa fee and if applicable, another money order for the return of the passport
