INLAND REVENUE DIVISION REMINDS PROPERTY OWNERS OF AUGUST 31 DEADLINE TO PAY 2026 PROPERTY TAX

St. George's, Grenada, August 17, 2026 – The Inland Revenue Division (IRD) is reminding property owners across Grenada, Carriacou, and Petite Martinique that the deadline to pay their **2026 Property Tax is August 31, 2026**.

Property owners are encouraged to ensure their property tax payments are made by the deadline to **avoid penalties**.

Property tax payments can be made conveniently **online at pay.gov.gd**, or in person at any **Inland Revenue Division office and District Revenue Office (DRO)**.

The Division also reminds property owners who believe their property assessment should be reviewed that they may submit a **Notice of Objection**. This process allows taxpayers to request a reassessment where circumstances may warrant a reduction in their property's assessed value.

Property owners, particularly those whose properties may have been affected by **Hurricane Beryl**, are encouraged to submit a completed Notice of Objection form where they believe the condition of their property warrants a review of its assessment.

Taxpayers requiring **payment assistance, general information, or guidance on filing an objection** are encouraged to visit their nearest Inland Revenue Division or District Revenue Office.

The Inland Revenue Division thanks the public for its continued cooperation and **commitment to national tax compliance**.

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
